COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS OF ONTARIO GUIDELINES FOR ANNUAL FEES

- An annual fee must be identified as a fee for uninsured services for a period of a year or more
- The services covered by this fee must be clearly stated in writing and understood by the patient
- The patient must be advised of the amount of the individual charges.
- The patient must be given the option of paying individual charges for the uninsured services as they are rendered.
- The decision as to whether or not to elect this form of payment must be the patient's and must not be a condition of the patient being accepted by the physician.
- The patient must be given a copy of the policy statement and indicate their acceptance of paying for uninsured services in this manner before being billed an annual fee.
- Fees for the services of being available to render a service cannot be charged in advance and are not to be included in the annual fee.
